The Strong Baby shower will be held on Saturday, May 13th, hosted by our WELCA group.



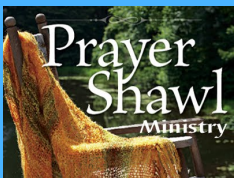
Why Join The Choir?

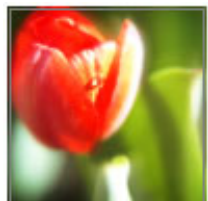
We Welcome Mark Gould
