The Strong Baby shower will be held on Saturday, May 13th, hosted by our WELCA group.

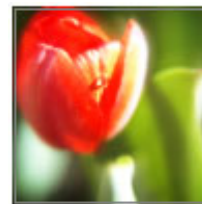


## Knitters Wanted! We Can Teach You!
