# 16 veterans to be featured in art show - free to the public

Warrior Songs is a Wisconsin non-profit organization committed to facilitating the healing of veterans through music and the creative arts. December 6th - 10th, Warrior Songs is hosting a Creative Arts Healing Retreat for 16 Midwest veterans in Racine, Wisconsin. The retreat culminates with an art show where the veterans will display their healing creations.

Doors open at 2:30 pm for a gallery viewing of the artwork created by the vets over the weekend. A presentation begins at 3:30 pm where the veterans will discuss their experience at the retreat and share their works. Coffee and light refreshments will be served. Doors close at 4:30 pm.
